
The Inventions Tournament

Objective: To examine how various inventions changed United States society.

Directions:

- 1. You and a partner will create a Google slideshow for your assigned invention.
 - a. One member of the partnership needs to create the slideshow.
 - b. This person needs to title the slideshow (use the invention as title) and share it with their partner and Mr. Koelzer (pkoelzer@livoniapublicschools.org)



- 2. Informational requirements for slideshow:
 - a. Who and when the invention was created.
 - b. The purpose of the invention.
 - c. How the invention has impacted American society, both in the short run (immediately) and in the long run (in the years that follow to the present).
 - d. Explanation as to why your invention is the greatest invention.
 - e. Counter argument against the first invention you are matched up against.
- 3. There are no specifications on the number of slides. This is up to you and your partner. The only requirement is that you have a title slide with the invention and the names of those involved with the group.
- 4. Each slide needs to have at least one picture.
- 5. Presentation requirements:
 - a. It is up to the members of the group as to who will talk in the presentation.
 - b. You need to explain in your presentation why your invention is better than the invention you are pitted against.
 - c. My suggestion is that you don't want to use all your information in the first round. You want to have some new information to share if your group moves onto other rounds.
